Boy Scout Merit Badges

As soon as a scout bridges into a troop, he may begin earning merit badges. Indicated by a small patch worn on an honor sash, these Boy Scouts of America (BSA) awards denote skills and areas of interest mastered by the scout. He may continue to earn badges until his 18th birthday.

Merit Badge Counselors

A scout must work with a merit badge counselor to earn the badge. These counselors are registered with the BSA and have experience in their subject either by vocation or avocation. They may register to work with scouts only within the troop with which they are affiliated, or they may offer their services to all scouts in the community.

Our troop maintains a list of merit badge counselors drawn from our own adult leadership. If a scout wishes to pursue a badge for which we have no counselors, he or his scout leader should contact the BSA district office to attempt to locate another counselor on file in the area.

Scout Buddies

BSA policy dictates no one-on-one contact between scouts and adult leaders; therefore, a scout may not work on a badge by himself with the counselor. While the scout buddy may be anyone---a parent, guardian, sibling or friend---finding another scout interested in earning the same badge may prove the most useful.

Merit Badge Book

The scout will need to obtain and read the booklet for the badge he wants to earn. These pamphlets include information on the subject, as well as a list of merit badge requirements the scout must complete.

The troop librarian maintains a collection of merit badge books. Some schools and libraries also have them to borrow, or the scout can purchase them directly from a scout shop or online at ScoutStuff.org.

The books may undergo a revision in January of each year. If a scout begins working with the requirements from an old book, he may continue with those requirements rather than having to switch to the new version, if one exists. Merit badge requirements are also available on the BSA's website, Scouting.org.

Merit Badge Workbooks

Many merit badge requirements involve written work. While not specifically required, workbooks accompany each book to help the scout keep his writing organized. Scouts can download and print workbooks for free from MeritBadge.org

Instructions on Completing Blue Cards

1. Prior to starting a Merit Badge, you must obtain a blue card from the Scoutmaster. The Scoutmaster will review your request to make sure the badge is appropriate and that you have met any/all prerequisites. He will sign the front of the blue card. You must complete all other necessary items **NEATLY**. Please see images.

Please make sure your name and merit badge are <u>PRINTED</u> **CLEARLY** on all three sections.



 When you have completed all of the requirements, the counselor will sign and date the circled portions of the blue card indicated by the circled areas below.


PARTIAL MERIT BADGES:

If you are attending the Merit Badge Academy or camp and do not complete all of the requirements, the counselor will return to you all 3 sections of the blue card. They will list the completed requirements, date, and initial in the



middle section (see #2). They will not sign any portion noted in the circles above.

 For completed merit badges, the counselor will keep their portion of the blue card. <u>BOTH</u> of the remaining sections must be returned to the scoutmaster.



5. Our policy within Troop 24 is to award only the patch for the Merit Badge within a month of the scout handing in the blue card. The Applicant's Record Section will be returned during the next Court of Honor. The scout should retain this section of the blue card in his scout records. It serves as proof of his work should the physical badge ever require replacement. Certain silver-sided badges are required to earn the rank of Eagle Scout.
